Sub: **Transfer of Paramedics and Ministerial Staff under Health and F.W.Deptt during the year 2013-14.**

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to say that it has come to notice of Govt., that some Paramedics and Ministerial Staff are continuing in a particular place/seat for years together. As a result, they are involved in so many illegal/irregular activities and creating problems due to their long stay. For better administration, Govt. has been pleased to decide that such type of Paramedics and Ministerial Staff need to be transferred from their present place of posting. Accordingly, the following steps may be taken for their transfer/change of seat.

- I) DHS (O), who is in charge of the combined Directorate of Health, may be instructed to change of seat among Ministerial Staff including Section Officers who have been completed more than three years in a particular seat in the Directorates. But, it will be decided through a committee consisting of the following members :
  - a) Director of Health Services, Odisha
  - b) Director of Medical, Education and Training, Odisha
  - c) Director of Family Welfare, Odisha
  - d) Director of Nursing, Odisha
  - e) Director of State of Institute of Health and Family Welfare, Odisha
  - f) Drug Controller, Odisha
- II) The Ministerial Staff who have completed three years in a particular seat under any CDMO may be shifted to another seat of his office or any sub-ordinate office like o/o S.D.M.O., C.H.C., P.H.C. etc.
- III) The Ministerial Staff who have completed six years in a particular place may be shifted to other place within the district by the concerned CDMOs. Since these are district cadre post.

IV) The paramedical staff like Pharmacists, Staff Nurse, Laboratory Technician, Radiographer, MPHW (F) and MPHW (M) etc. who have completed more than six years in a particular place may be shifted to other place by the CDMOs in the district. But, such decision as at II,III & IV will be taken through a committee consisting of the following members:


- a) CDMO
- b) ADMO, Medical/Deputy C.M.O
- c) Hospital Manager
- d) District Project Manager. NRHM

V) Besides, as regards inter district transfer of state cadre employees (Non-Gazetted Group-C category) such as Technical Store Keeper, Nursing Sister, Ophthalmic Asst., Non-Medical supervisor, Multipurpose Health Supervisor and etc. may be done by respective Directors under this Deptt. in consonance with the transfer policy of G.A. Deptt. from time to time read with Health and Family Welfare Deptt. Resolution No.11429 Dt 20.04.2006(copy enclosed) during the general transfer season i.e. between 15<sup>th</sup> April to 15<sup>th</sup> June 2013.

As such, all transfer proposals pending in this Deptt. are forwarded herwith to concerned Directors with a request to take appropriate decision at his level and complete the exercise by the end of general transfer season i.e 15.06.2013 positively under intimation to this Deptt.


Any deviation in this regard shall be seriously viewed by Govt.
